

# St. Patrick's Day Downtown 2012

## PARADE INVITATION!

The Tallahassee Irish Society (TIS) and the Tallahassee Downtown Improvement Authority (TDIA) would like to invite you to participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Day Downtown Parade on Saturday, March 17, 2012.

TIS and the TDIA are the lead organizations responsible for planning, organizing, and conducting the parade. This year there will be TV coverage. Many groups are signing up. The parade will begin at 3:30 p.m. starting at College and Macomb Street and ending at College and Adams Street. Preceding the parade, at 2:30 p.m., there will be a 5K Run and Walk. Following the parade is the St. Patrick's Day Downtown Street Festival from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. on the Adams Street Commons.

The downtown street festival will feature **Scots on the Rock** band on stage all seven hours at the north end of the commons. The stage at the south end by city hall will have Irish singers, dancers and music. On the commons between the stages will be booths for cultural and civic demonstrations with lots of vendors for food and drink and beer.

All parade entries must display a sign, banner or some other means of identification. There will be no entry charge for participating in this year's St. Patrick's Day Downtown Parade. Beginning around 2:30 p.m., parade participants will gather at the staging area on Park Ave between Macomb Street and Bronough Street.
